11/24: US - Night on board

11/25: Cairo

11/26: Cairo

Breakfast at the hotel. Discover the Egyptian capital today with a **guided tour of Cairo's most iconic sights**. Start at the Giza Plateau, home to the **legendary Great Pyramids**—constructed over 4,500 years ago and recognized as one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World! Explore these architectural marvels and uncover their fascinating history as you walk in the footsteps of the pharaohs. Continue to the Great Sphinx and the Valley Temple to reveal more secrets of Ancient Egypt.

In the afternoon, visit the world-renowned **Egyptian Museum**, which houses the largest collection of jewels, relics, and statues from the golden age of the pharaohs. Afterwards, take a stroll through the vibrant **Khan el-Khalili neighborhood**, home to the city's largest and most famous bazaar*.

The rest of the day is yours to enjoy at leisure. We recommend ending the day with an optional evening tour of Cairo, complete with dinner**. Overnight stay in Cairo.

11/27: Cairo - Aswan

Breakfast at the hotel. This morning, transfer to the airport for an early short flight to **Aswan**, a city on the Nile River renowned for its importance in Ancient Egyptian history. Upon arrival, embark on a **guided city tour** starting with the Aswan Dam. Continue to the Granite Quarry, home to the famous unfinished obelisk, and then visit the impressive High Dam of Aswan.

Next, transfer to the port to board your **Nile cruise ship**, your home for the next three nights. Settle into your cabin and take in the stunning river views. Enjoy **lunch** on board, and in the afternoon, embark on a **relaxing cruise aboard a traditional felucca** to admire the scenic beauty of the Nile and its famous cataracts. Watch life unfold along the riverbanks as you sail. **Dinner** and overnight on board.

11/28: Aswan – Kom Ombo

Full-board on board. Today, if you're an early riser, you have the chance to enjoy an optional excursion to **Abu Simbel***, home to many rock-carved temples. Afterwards, we recommend to take the chance to book an optional visit to the Island of Philae**. A river island in the Nile where the ancient temple of the goddess Isis is located. Afterwards, navigate northwards towards Kom Ombo. Upon arrival explore the **twin Temples of Haroeris and Sobek** and see the amazing Nilometer, used to measure the rising and falling levels of the Nile, an important life source in Egypt. Later, visit a unique **Crocodile Mummy museum**, home to a number of mummified crocodiles. Return to the ship and enjoy relaxing on board. Dinner and overnight on board.

***Optional Excursion to Abu Simbel:** Visit these amazing temples, carved on the western cliff of the desert by Ramses II in the XI century BC. See the iconic 20-metre high statues, dedicated to the god Amon Ra, and the Temple of Nefertari, dedicated to the goddess Hathor.

Please note: If you take the optional excursion to Abu Simbel, you will depart from the ship at approximately 3 a.m. to make the most of the coolest and quietest part of the day. This way, you can fully experience Abu Simbel without the crowds and avoid sightseeing in high temperatures.

** **Optional Island of Philae Excursion:** Discover the historic island of Philae, in the reservoir of the Old Aswan Dam. It is home to the ancient ruins of the Temple of Isis and offers a fascinating insight into life and beliefs in Ancient Egypt.

11/29: Edfu – Luxor

Full board on board. Transfer to the **Temple of Edfu** and take time to explore this magnificent site, dedicated to the Egyptian god Horus. It is one of the best-preserved monuments in Egypt, its grand structure having been protected for centuries by desert sands.

Return to the ship and continue your journey to **Luxor**, where the ancient heart of Thebes awaits. Discover the breathtaking **Temple of Luxor**, built by the great pharaohs Amenhotep III and Ramses II. Return to the ship for dinner and an overnight stay on board.

11/30: Luxor

Breakfast on board. Continue your discovery of the ancient city of Thebes today as you head to the world-famous **Valley of the Kings***, where the tomb of Tutankhamon was discovered, revealing the riches of the ancient pharaohs. It is here that the most powerful and influential kings of Ancient Egypt were buried. After exploring the site, continue to the **Temple of Hatshepsut**, an imposing terraced structure, located below towering cliffs. Bid farewell to this world of ancient kings and queens as you cross the river into modern-day **Luxor**. Transfer to the hotel and enjoy the remainder of the afternoon at your leisure. We recommend an optional Karnak Temple Sound and Light Show**. Overnight stay in Luxor.

*Please note: The excursion to the Valley of the Kings includes visits to three tombs. Entrance to the tomb of Tutankhamun is not included but, if you are interested in visiting, you can buy a ticket to see this tomb at the site during your visit.

Optional **Karnak Temple Sound and Light Show: Visit the largest open-air museum in Egypt, the **Karnak Temple** in **Luxor**. Discover the secrets behind the temple's ancient name, **Thebes**, and explore its significant monuments. As you wander through the ruins of this once great complex, you will be guided by the voices of the **pharaohs** who built this site to honor their god **Amon**. Watch as the temples and statues come to life with the clever use of special effects, relive the times of the ancient pharaohs with their customs and rituals as they recount the dramatic history of ancient Thebes.

12/01: Luxor – Cairo

Breakfast at the hotel. Set off early in the morning to visit the **Karnak Temple Complex**, home to a vast array of decayed temples, chapels, pylons, and other ancient buildings. Explore the ruins as you soak up the unique atmosphere and let your imagination run wild as you learn about life in Ancient Egypt. At the indicated time, transfer to the airport for a flight back to **Cairo**. Arrive and transfer to the hotel. The remainder of the day is free at your leisure. We recommend an optional excursion to the Saladin Citadel.* If you wish to dive even deeper into the fascinating Egyptian culture, don't miss our optional visit to the spectacular new Grand Egyptian Museum.* An unforgettable experience that will connect you with the treasures of an ancient civilization.** Overnight stay in Cairo.

***Optional Excursion to Saladin Citadel**: Visit the Alabaster Mosque and medieval fortification of Saladin Citadel, perched atop a hill in central Cairo and dating back to the 12th-century. Learn about the importance of the site to Egypt's Islamic heritage before walking through the Coptic Neighborhood, home to various churches.

****Optional Visit to the Grand Egyptian Museum**: Discover the Grand Egyptian Museum in Cairo, which houses over 50,000 artifacts spanning 7,000 years of history. With breathtaking views of the Pyramids, it features highlights such as the Hanging Obelisk and the impressive Grand Gallery, making it a truly unforgettable experience.

12/02: Cairo - US

Breakfast at the hotel*. At the indicated time, transfer to the airport for a flight back to the US. Arrive in the US** and end your extraordinary trip.

**Depending on the choice of flight, you may arrive back in the US the following day.

- Light Even though you will be seated most of the time, you may be required to walk short distances or climb some steps.

- Active You will be required to walk for a few hours on comfortable terrain.
- Challenging A good level of fitness is required. You will be required to walk on difficult terrain and/or for long periods of time.
